Production

The children will develop their singing, acting, dancing and performance skills.

DT

We will be learning about how pulleys work. We will be designing and making a controllable vehicle which uses a pulley within an electrical circuit. We will then evaluate it.

Science - Evolution and Inheritance - Light

The children will continue to develop their understanding of how living things have changed over time. They will learn more about the scientist Charles Darwin. They will also develop their scientific enquiry skills and understanding by exploring the topic 'light'.
