Our fiction text is a Journey story called 'Adventures in Space'.

Poetry- writing and acting out poems

Music

We will be having weekly visits from Luton Music Service, learning how to play the Pbone.

Art

Exploring one-point perspective (using a vanishing point) when drawing architecture. Developing understanding of architecture, design and change over time.

Computing

Children will learn about how a flat-file database can be used to organise data in records. Pupils will use tools within a database to order and answer questions about data.

Science – Earth and Space

Children will learn that the Earth is part of the solar system and that the Sun is at the centre of that system. They will learn the names of the other planets (based on their distance from the Sun) and be able to describe the movement of Earth (and other planets) in relation to the Sun.

History/ Geography

History – Children will explore who played a part in the success of the space race and significant individuals who made a difference.

Geography – Locate the countries, use globes/maps to recognise Earth from space. To understand and give co-ordinates of longitude and latitude.

PSHE

RE

Children will learn about key elements of the Hindu faith and analyse how these beliefs influence individuals to be 'good'.
