

### Reference: PGL Trip to Little Canada, Isle of Wight

Thank you for expressing an interest in your child attending a school trip to Little Canada, Isle of Wight from Friday, 17<sup>th</sup> May to Monday, 20<sup>th</sup> May 2024.

The trip will be organised through PGL Travel Ltd.

#### What is a PGL Multi Activity Trip?

### What does it cost?

The cost per person is approximately £300 with a 20% pupil premium reduction the cost will be £240 which can be paid in instalments prior to the trip. Pupils who wish to take part will have a booking made with the tour operator, by the school, on their behalf and it is understood that all conditions of the booking are as laid down by the tour operator. For example, deposits are non-refundable once they have been forwarded to the tour operator, except for cancellation due to medical reasons, confirmed by a doctor. We are currently finalising the travel arrangements. We have based the cost on the company's estimated ferry prices and as soon as travel arrangements can be finalised and the numbers attending confirmed we will advise of any change this makes to the total cost. The cost includes:

- Return coach travel from school
- Ferry crossing
- A full daily programme of adventure activities
- Fun evening entertainment
- All meals and accommodation
- Fully comprehensive travel insurance (details available on the PGL website)

If you would like your child to take part in this exciting trip, please log on to your child's Eduspot account to pay the initial deposit of £35 by Friday 15<sup>th</sup> September 2023. (Please contact Hilary Wilson hwilson@bramingham.net if you wish to discuss help with payment arrangements) Please also tick to give your initial consent for your child to take part and your agreement to abide by the terms and conditions laid down by the tour operator.

(Please note **deposits are non-refundable**. Please refer to PGL Terms and Conditions for details of **cancellation charges**.)

A full payment schedule will be provided in September with deadline dates for payments to be submitted to PGL. Once deposits are collected and numbers confirmed the remaining costs will be available for payment on Eduspot with the option to pay in as many instalments as you require.
