Dear Parents,

As part of Year 3's topic on the Stone Age, we are excited to offer our Year 3 children a visit to Celtic Harmony Stone Age Village in Brickendon, Hertfordshire on Tuesday 19th March 2024.

The children will have the opportunity to:

- watch the friction fire lighting display.
- Gather food in the forest and cook with prehistoric herbs.
- Build their own woodland shelter.
- See the flint knapping demonstration, view stone tools, and hunt the mammoth!
- Become Stone Age traders, with authentic props such as skins, horns, and hammer stones.

The children will need to arrive in school at 8.40am and we will leave school promptly at 8.55am, returning in time for the end of the school day. Please can all children wear school uniform with jogging bottoms, including a warm coat and trainers, wellies, or comfy shoes as they will be walking around the outdoor museum throughout the day. All children will need a packed lunch, no fizzy drinks please. **If your child is entitled to a free school meal,** the kitchen can organise a packed lunch. This does not include a drink which you will need to provide for your child (no fizzy drinks please). **We will text you nearer the time to ask if your child requires a packed lunch.**

The cost of this trip is £34.25 per child and we are asking for a voluntary contribution of this amount. The amount includes £3 spending money to enable the children to swap their pocket money for Celtic gold coins to trade for precious items in the shop. Unfortunately, if insufficient contributions are received, the trip will not be able to take place.

Please could we kindly ask that you log on to your child's Eduspot account to add your voluntary contribution and tick the parental consent box no later than Friday 29th February 2024. We hope you will agree this will be a fantastic learning opportunity for your child.
