

English

We will be reading *Street Child* (which links to our Victorian topic). Our fiction text is a 'rags to riches' tale based on the life of a street child.

Our non-fiction text is an autobiography, focusing on the life of Dr Barnardo.

Music

We will be following the Charanga music scheme. We will be learning to sing and play along to the song 'Livin' On A Prayer' with a particular focus on rhythm, rifts and how Rock music developed from the Beatles onwards.

Art

Children will be creating a poetry zine using printing and collage. They will combine printing with painting and collage to create a visual poetry zine.

Science

During this unit, children will learn about different forces and their effects.

What was life like as a Victorian child in Luton?

History

Children will learn about what life was like in Victorian Luton. This will be linked to a local history study where we will be exploring Luton in the Victorian era e.g. hat making.

PSHE
