Bramingham Lunches

We are very pleased to introduce our in-house school catering "*Bramingham Lunches*." We provide a three-week menu rotation, which we hope the children will enjoy. The menus are available on the school website www.bramingham.net

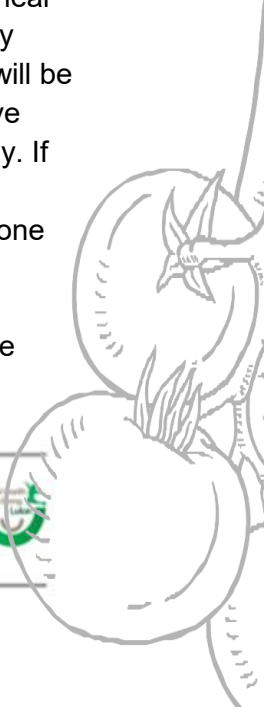
We hope you will notice the menu has old favourites, with lots of new additions taken from our families' suggestions. There are *paninis, bagels, wraps, noodles, pasta dishes with several Halal* options, not forgetting side dishes including Yorkshire pudding with our roast dinners! We also offer a salad bar and fruit options every day. We hope including a fresh snack pot and choices such as summer fruits and watermelon will encourage the children to eat more fruit and vegetables and every day there will be a side offering of bread or a garlic or naan bread option.

All meals will be charged at £2.60 per day from Year 3, with Reception Year, Years 1 & 2 receiving universal free school meals.

Pre-Ordering Lunches

School lunches can be booked and paid for in School Money (eduspot), the system already used in school, and even where there is no payment to make in KS1 or free school meals, we kindly ask that school lunches are pre-ordered. **If your child is bringing a packed lunch from home please could you complete this as a choice in school money**, (this greatly helps us save valuable lesson time and avoids any lunchtime confusion.) By ordering a meal in advance you help us to plan, avoid waste and keep meal costs as low as possible. You can amend your meal selections up until midnight the day before. You will need to go to the basket to finalise any amendments, but no payment will be taken, and you can view your changes on the receipt emailed to you. Where meals have been chosen at home and pre-ordered, school will not be able to change this on the day. If you have pre-ordered and your child is absent from school, we will ensure the meal is cancelled and any refund applicable is made. Please be careful if you have more than one child in school that you have selected their name prior to ordering.

When starting at the school a link to set up your eduspot (school money) account will be issued. When visiting your eduspot account you will see "Dinners" as an option.



Please select the week you wish to order and then by clicking on the day you will see the meal options available. When ordering, allergens will be displayed for you.

Where children have a specialised diet due to allergies, we require information signed by a medical professional, we are then able to substitute ingredients to ensure a wider choice, wherever possible. Where desserts are dairy based, there will always be an alternative option.
