

English

In our Talk 4 Writing sessions the children will be learning how to retell a story using a story map and actions. Within our writing we will be focussing on letter formation and how words join together to make sentences using finger spaces, capital letters and full stops.

Science

The children will be learning names for body parts and using their senses to explore the world around them. Through activities, they will understand how the use of senses are linked to body parts.

Maths

The children will be learning how to count accurately from a group of objects and recording this, using different representations. They will develop the skill of counting forwards and backwards from any number. The children are continuing to develop accurate number formation.

Autumn 1 Year 1 What makes me unique?

Music

The children will be learning key vocabulary in music and performing to others. They will have the opportunity to learn about musical notes using the glockenspiel.

History/Geography

In history the children will learn about changes within living memory by thinking about what their family looks like and creating a family tree.

In geography the children will be learning about the United Kingdom, capital cities and landmarks.

PSHE

The children are learning about ourselves and others; similarities, differences and individuality. The children will also learn the correct names external for body parts.

Art

The children will be learning how to mix primary colours to make secondary colours. They will then explore how to create circles in the style of 'Kandinsky' to create a Year 1 collage.

Computing

The children will enjoy learning directional language with a moving, programmable robot.

RE

The children are learning about Christianity and the characteristics of God through parables.

PE

The children will be learning how to move with control at different speeds. They will learn how to co-ordinate moves and balances. They will also learn about how our bodies change during exercise.
