

English

We are continuing to look at how to write a newspaper. We will then learn about letter writing based on our visit to the Space Centre.

Science – Earth and Space

Children will learn that the Earth is part of the solar system and that the Sun is at the center of that system. They will learn the names of the other planets (based on their distance from the Sun) and be able to describe the movement of Earth (and other planets) in relation to the Sun.

Maths

Children will be learning how to multiply fractions and finding fractions of amounts. They will then be moving onto looking at equivalent fractions, percentages and decimals.
