English

Our fiction work will be 'Defeat the monster' stories with a focus on action.

We will be writing discussion texts as part of our non-fiction unit.

Class readers: Empire's End: A Roman Story and Escape from Pompeii.

For Christians, what was the impact of Pentecost? We will be learning about Christian beliefs, including the Kingdom of God, the Holy Spirit and the importance of Pentecost.

Computing

We will be learning how and why data is collected over time. We will collect, analyse and input data.

Science

What happens when there is a break in the circuit? We will be learning about electricity and the components needed for a simple circuit. We will investigate what makes a circuit complete or incomplete and plan our own investigations into electrical conductors and insulators.
