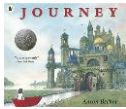


English

What will we find in a castle?

Maths

Children will learn to read and write numbers using numerals and words to at least 100. They will identify, represent and estimate numbers using different representations. They will recognise the place value of each digit in a two digit number. They will compare and order numbers using $<$, $>$ and $=$ signs.

Music

We are learning a song, 'Hands, Feet and Heart' and developing our glockenspiel skills.

History/Geography

We are learning the 7 continents and 5 oceans and 4 points on a compass. We are also investigating features of a castle and where some are located. We will be visiting Warwick Castle.

PSHE

We are learning about how to stay safe, what safe risk is and what online safety looks like.

Art/DT

We are exploring the work of Georgia O'Keeffe and Vincent Van Gogh, then creating artwork based on these artists.

Computing

We will be learning how to use given commands in different orders to investigate how the order affects the outcome. We will also learn about design in programming.

PE

Children will learn how to move their bodies in a variety of ways and know how to control their movements. They will learn about the changes that occur to their body when they exercise.

RE

We are learning about places that hold religious significance with a focus on Christianity and Islam.
