Music

Our learning is focused on revisiting songs and musical activities, a context for the History of Music and the beginnings of the Language of Music.

Science

We will be continuing to learn about living things and their habitats. We will be learning about the foods that different animals eat and creating food chains to show this. At the end of the half term, we will be observing our plants and making notes of any changes.

Geography
