Bramingham turns 30!

We hope that your children have thoroughly enjoyed their first week back. You may be aware from our school Facebook site, that this year is an extra special year for Bramingham, as the school turns 30 years old. We are hosting three events to mark this special occasion.

Friday 15th September

On Friday the 15th we have planned a very exciting day for the children. The children will be participating in a variety of sessions from different areas of our curriculum and beyond; these include music, art, science, design and technology and drama. We even have a mobile zoo coming to visit for the day! All the children have a slightly different day dependent upon their year group. Photos of the day will be shared on our school Facebook account.

Key points for the day:

- The children need to come into school wearing their **PE kit**
- Children in Squirrels, Robins, Swifts, Wrens and Foxes need to come into school at normal time
- Children in Owls, Rabbits, Hedgehogs, Badgers, Frogs, Magpies, Doves and Kestrels need to arrive at school at **8.20am** via their classroom doors as their activities will be starting earlier
- The day finishes at normal time

Saturday 16th September

On Saturday night, it's time for the adults to celebrate from 7.30pm until late (in the main hall). Tickets are £10 and can now be also bought from our main office as well as via the link on our Facebook site. Our favourite DJ is making a return to mark this special occasion and your ticket price also includes food.

Friday 22nd September

We are holding Bramingham's very first Colour Run. This will take place on our school track with children taking part at different times throughout the afternoon.

What do I need to know?

Please send your child into school wearing their PE kit with a plain white t shirt in a carrier bag that is clearly labelled with their name and class. They will put their t-shirts on after lunch, before the event starts. The children also need a pair of sunglasses, goggles or protective eyewear to protect their eyes from paint. When the children have finished their run, they will be encouraged to wipe off the excess paint.

Every child will do a thirty-minute colour run to mark the 30 years since Bramingham first opened. The paint used is completely safe, washable and more information can be found via this website <https://www.ukschoolrun.com/colour-run>. Here are answers to the two most common questions from the site we are using:

Does the colour powder stain clothing? Like any other colour powder, ours can stain clothing. Please be aware of this when using the colour powder and advise participants to wear clothing they don't mind having more colours on them after the event than before!

Can I wash colour powder out of my hair? Yes you can! Rinse your hair with cold water first to remove as much as possible, then wash using a good quality shampoo.

This will be a sponsored event and all children will come home today with a sponsorship form. Just like with our Royal Ramble last academic year, every pound raised will equate to an epraise point for your child. The money raised will be combined with the money from our Royal Ramble to purchase more inclusive equipment for our playground.

Sponsorship money will be due in on Tuesday 3rd October.
