English

We will be looking at the play 'Macbeth' by William Shakespeare..

We will be learning how to develop suspense in our writing and writing poetry. We will also be writing a discussion text about one of the key themes in Macbeth

Our comprehension sessions will include a variety of texts from different genres.

Music

Focusing on jazz music and learning to play simple songs on the recorder.

Art

The children will be developing their drawing skills and clay techniques.

They will be designing and making an abstract clay sculpture inspired by the modern sculptors, Henry Moore.

Science
