Dear Parents,

You may be aware from media coverage that the NEU have declared strike action. The first day of the action will take place on Wednesday 1st February. The strike is happening because of a national dispute between the unions and the government over teachers' pay, and not because of any issues at our school.

We are getting in touch to give you as much notice as possible about our arrangements for Wednesday 1st February. We are grateful to our teachers for letting us know their decisions as they are under no obligation to do so.

There will be no school on Wednesday 1st February for the following classes:

Year 6 – Kestrels and Year 6 - Doves

Year 5 – Frogs

Year 4 – Hedgehogs and Year 4 – Badgers

Year 3 – Rabbits

Year 2 – Wrens and Year 2 - Foxes

For these children, we encourage that they complete all four of the Doodle apps on the day of the strike.

The rest of the school will be open as usual and the children in – Red and Grey Squirrels, Robins, Swifts, Owls and Magpies – **are expected to be in school.**

We are sorry that you will have to make alternative arrangements for your child at short notice. We are working closely with our staff union members to keep up to date with the situation, and we will inform you as soon as possible if arrangements change further.
