We will be studying 'Jack and the Beanstalk' and creating our own 'Defeat the Monster' stories.

We will be learning about 'Diamonte' poems, writing our own and performing them.

Music

We will be learning about 'reggae'. We will be using the song Zootime by Joanna Mangona to support the unit.

We will be listening, improvising, appraising and completing different musical activities.

Art

We will be studying the question - How can we make a 3D object (pot) from clay? This has a sculpture focus linked to the artist Esther Mahlangu.

Science

We will be learning about what plants need in order to grow and stay healthy. We will be observing and describing how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants.

History

We will be learning about the history of Luton with a focus on the hat making industry. We will also learn about the history of the Luton Carnival.

Computing

We will be learning about IT all around us and how it helps us in everyday life. We will identify common types of technology, demonstrate how IT devices work together and explain how and why we use it.
