

English

Our work will be based on the myth, 'Theseus and the Minotaur' with the focus of developing action within our writing, using a range of techniques. We will also focus on speech using another Greek myth.

Our daily comprehension sessions will be, mostly, linked to this half term's topic.

Science

Children will learn about the heart, the circulatory system, pulse rate and the effects of exercise, and healthy eating.

Year 6 – Autumn 1 How have the Ancient Greeks influenced our world today?

History

We will be learning about what life was like in Ancient Greece and how the Ancient Greeks have influenced our world today.

PSHE

This unit will link to health and wellbeing. It will focus on looking after ourselves, mentally and physically and taking more responsibility/becoming more independent in doing so.

Computing

The children will be recognising how the WWW can be used to communicate and be searched to find information.

RE

We will be learning about how faith is expressed in Islam.

Maths

We will be focusing on place value, number (including standard written methods for addition, subtraction, multiplication and addition).

French

The children will be learning about French cities. They will apply previous skills and knowledge of topic areas such as places in a town, directions, homes and numbers to develop their speaking and listening abilities.

PE

In the children's indoor lesson, they will be developing their stamina by taking part in circuit training.

In their outdoor lesson, they will be focusing on invasion games and applying skills in both hockey and basketball.

Music

We will be listening to, learning to sing and composing music inspired by 'Happy' by Pharrell Williams.

Art

The children will be developing their water colour skills and techniques. They will be observing how other artists represent light, water and reflection and then will produce their own artwork based on an artist's style.
